of our own language is learned by use, not learning the rules.

This has been a safe warm place over winter and will continue by popular demand to grow our connections with one another. ACTION means All Coming Together in our neighbourhood.

April was a wet, windy and challenging month for us all. It reminded me of the Simon and Garfunkel song – 'April, come she will, when streams are ripe and swelled with rain.' Let's hope that 'May, she will stay resting in my arms again.'

I'm reminded with gratitude in our post Easter services that Jesus rose from death, breaking its hold on us, and was recognised not by how he looked, or even (though very important) what he said about Scripture being fulfilled by the Easter Cross. He was recognised by two followers at Emmaus about 7 miles outside Jerusalem after walking with them for some time discussing stuff, only when he shared a simple homely meal with them. What opened their eyes was the familiar way Jesus was always so thankful for food with friends, breaking bread, blessing and sharing it. May we find times this May, maybe, to be thankful for one another, to share simple homely times and recognise the risen Christ in one another and the world around us. Join the **Blue Campaign** and make Hurst Green a haven for wildlife!
The network of grass verges in Surrey stretches alongside 3,000 miles of rural and urban roads, providing a significant opportunity to increase plant



and insect biodiversity through the way that these are managed. Reducing the number of grass cuts each year can allow native plant species to thrive, and in some areas additional steps can be taken to prepare the ground, sow native wildflower seeds and more proactively encourage their growth.

You can join the Blue Campaign by agreeing an area to be left uncut with your neighbours' then contacting Surrey County Council to ensure your verge is suitable for being left uncut. Scroll down to the 'contact us' link on: https://www.surreycc.gov.uk/roads-and-transport/roadworks-and-maintenance/treesgrass-and-hedges/grass/the-blue-campaign-increasing-biodiversity-in-grass-verges, select 'Planting a blue heart on the verge' as the form option, pinpoint the specific verge or green area on the map, and use the text box within the form to add any specific comments.

You can make your own blue heart or contact Men In Sheds on 01883 715189 or thewoodhousecentre@gmail.com, who are making a limited number in wood with a planting stake, either pre-decorated or for you to decorate yourself.

Hurst Green Singers Summer Concert

Just a few weeks away, Hurst Green Singers' Summer)INGERS Concert on 13th May is fast approaching and the choir is busy rehearsing to ensure it gives an exceptionally polished performance for this special occasion. The evening of inspirational music will continue the happy mood and excitement generated by the Coronation celebrations which take place the weekend before.

The varied programme curated by the Music Director, James Meaders, will include John Rutter's Te Deum, a jubilant hymn of praise; and Handel's much loved Zadok the Priest, composed for the Coronation of King George II and sung at the Coronation of every British monarch since. The main feature will be the magnificent Nelson Mass by Haydn, thought by many to be his greatest composition. Written 225 years ago in turbulent times after Napoleon Bonaparte had defeated the Austrian army in four major battles and was threatening its capitol Vienna, the masterpiece is an impassioned work of great drama. Haydn called his work the 'Missa in Angustiis' or Mass for Troubled Times, which definitely resonates with today's global problems. However, it was first performed on the day that Nelson defeated Napoleon at the Battle of the Nile – and hence is known as the Nelson Mass.

The local choir will be accompanied by an orchestra and the solo voice parts in the work will be performed by highly accomplished singers from the Royal Academy of Music: Emilia Bertolini (Soprano); Hera Protopapas (Mezzo-Soprano); Guy Benon (Tenor) and Alex Bower-Brown (Baritone).

The Summer Concert will take place in the Bawtree Hall, Hazelwood School, Oxted on Saturday 13 th May at 7.00pm. Tickets are priced at £15 and can be ordered from hurstgreensingers@gmail.com or at the door (unless previously sold out).

This year the money raised in Christian Aid Week will help farmers in Malawi plant better seeds, secure a fairer price for the crops, and build happier futures for their children.

Malawi is a beautiful country of cooler mountains in the north, the shimmering waters of Lake Malawi in the east, and sun-drenched lowlands to the south. But in Malawi, the costs of everyday essentials, such as food and fuel, are going up and up, just as they are here. In addition, the climate crisis means it is increasingly difficult to grow many of the foods that families used to eat and sell. Often crops are lost to cyclones or droughts, or seeds are too old to grow well. Many farmers are exploited by big companies and don't receive a fair price for their crops. However, Christian Aid partners in Malawi are helping farmers transform their livelihoods using the humble but mighty pigeon pea: a drought-resistant, soil-revitalising, high-protein, low-cost, delicious crop. Farmers and communities are working with Christian Aid to form cooperatives to secure a fairer price, boost the quality of the seeds they use, adding value by baking and selling bread made from pea flour, and building warehouses to keep peas safe from weather events.
