Will you give something up or take something up for Lent?

The middle of February will herald Pancake Day, as it is commonly known - or Shrove Tuesday, for those of us who remember that it precedes the day known as Ash Wednesday, which is the start of Lent. In majority Catholic countries, it is celebrated as Mardi Gras (Fat Tuesday) or Carnivale, a day of partying and excess before a solemn religious season which is traditionally accompanied by fasting.



Lent is a period of time which prepares us for Good Friday and for Easter. In this time, we do things which draw us closer to God; the reason for fasting is that it allows us to focus instead on prayer and notice our simpler blessings.

These days, very few people in this country will partake in a religious fast, though some may still think to 'give something up' for Lent - especially chocolate. In recent years, I have stopped giving something up, and instead taken something up. Personally, I find that doing something deliberate is a better way for me to draw closer to God and to the things which really matter to me.

I invite you all to join with me this season by giving to and finding solace in our local community. The Hurst Green Community Fridge, which runs out of Aggies Hall, is open to everyone each Wednesday for an hour, from 11.15. We have fresh and tinned food available for free which has been donated to us by supermarkets and individuals. We also serve tea, coffee and biscuits, and invite everyone who attends to sit for a while over a cuppa.



Perhaps the 'thing' you offer during Lent will be an hour of your time each week to chat with others, and share a cup of tea with others in the community who you might not otherwise encounter. If you don't have an hour on a Wednesday to visit us, you could think of other things which draw you closer - for example writing a letter, letting someone know you're thinking of them.

And, if it's pancakes you're after, do join us at St John's at 11am on Sunday 18th February for our monthly Community Brunch, where we will be serving pancakes with the traditional toppings - vegan and gluten-free diets catered for too!

Save our frogs and toads!

Well, it's nearly that time of year again, when a young toad's thoughts turn to love! Over the next few weeks you may catch sight of frogs and toads crossing the road near St John's Church at, and approaching, the junction between Church Way and Oast Road.



What are the differences between frogs and toads? Frogs have smooth, moist skin, and they aren't slimy! They tend to jump rather than crawl. Toads, on the other hand, have drier skin. They don't need to spend their lives so close to water. They lumber about when they move instead of hopping.

Both frogs and toads are known as amphibians because they live partly on land and partly in the water and travel back each year to the pond where they were bred. This happens in late winter/early spring after it begins to get dark and often following a rainy day. They don't like the cold so the temperature needs to be reasonably mild otherwise they will stay put in someone's garden for a little longer in their snug spot in the undergrowth, or a woodpile, or a hole in the ground. Then when the conditions seem right, they set out on their journey – and they don't have any road sense!

So, from early or mid-February until early April there are likely to be frogs and toads in Church Way and in Oast Road near the T-junction in the hours after dusk. These little amphibians can be seen and avoided if we drive slowly and carefully in that area.

We have a Toad Patrol in place to help them on their journey, but sometimes we don't have enough people to cover the whole of an evening.



Lent Climate Pilgrimage, 17 February 2024

Lead Bishop on the environment, Bishop Martin, is organising a series of six walks in Southwark Diocese on different days during Lent, to shine a spotlight on the climate and ecological crisis and to encourage personal and systemic change, finishing at Southwark Cathedral on 28 March.

The first walk is on **Saturday 17 February at 10am from Reigate to Chaldon**, a 7-mile semi-rural walk on the North Downs. It is mainly off road, with two steep climbs and a minibus option for those who may find these difficult. The theme of this walk is biodiversity, farming and transport, with part of the walk crossing the M25, and plans for a farm stop on route. The route starts at The Yard at Reigate Station: 3a The Facade, Holmesdale Road, Reigate, Surrey RH2 0BB. (entrance Gates Opposite China House Restaurant).
